Q: Please give us tips for avoiding scams?

Unfortunately, this is a timely request. This time of year there is an increase in the number of scams. There are warning signs to these scams. If you hear these or similar lines, be alert that it is likely a scam:

- "You must act now, or the offer won't be good."
- "We will send you a check, and you just deposit • it."
- "You've won a free gift, vacation, or prize, but you have to pay for postage and handling or other charges."
- "You can't afford to miss this high-profit, no-risk offer."

Some tips for avoiding telemarketing fraud:

- Don't buy from an unfamiliar company. Legitimate businesses understand that you want more information about their company and are happy to comply.
- Always ask for and wait until you receive written material about any offer or charity. If you get

brochures about costly investments, ask someone whose financial advice you trust to review them.

You can always check out unfamiliar companies with the Better Business Bureau or the state attorney general.




