National Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day, also referred to as Pearl Harbor Remembrance Day or Pearl Harbor Day, is observed annually in the United States on Dec. 7, to remember and honor the 2,403 United States citizens who were killed in the Japanese surprise attack on Pearl Harbor in Hawaii on Dec. 7, 1941 which led to the United States declaring war on Japan the next day and thus entering World War II.

Tune in at 3:30 p.m. Monday, Dec. 7, and hear President Roosevelt's full speech in which he declares war on Japan. Following the nearly five minute presidential address, Channel 1960 will air a virtual tour of the USS Arizona Memorial, which is located in Oahu, Hawaii.

KN95 masks, like N95 respirators, consist typically of several layers of a polypropylene plastic polymer, a synthetic material. KN95 masks are the next level down from the N95 respirators, which require fit testing. This is an great opportunity to stock up for the winter months with a high-quality and effective mask.




