Lunch will be delivered between 11:30 a.m. and 1 p.m. Cost is \$6 per boxed meal. Meal prices vary by entrée.

COVID-19 Vaccine: Reminders regarding timing



The State of Kansas shared a plan for providing vaccinations, which has been very fluid as new challenges emerge. Vaccinations for staff and residents will be provided to Adult Care Homes (Nursing facilities, Assisted Living & Homes Plus) directly through pharmacies and are expected to arrive before the end of the December.

At this time we do not know how future vaccines will be administered. We do know that **independent living residents** will be included in the second phase of vaccinating along with all other residents of the county who are over the age of 65. Phase 2 of vaccinations, including IL residents, will occur no earlier than February 2021. We do not anticipate any additional information about vaccination dates or locations until some time in January.

Art Engagement from the Beach Museum of Art

If you have a bird feeder in your yard year-round you will notice the species of birds change with the

seasons. Of course, the birds you observe migrating into and away from your community also depends on where you live in the United States. In Manhattan, Kan. the Hummingbird and Oriole will migrate to states south of Kansas for the winter. The Dark-eyed Junco and Redbreasted Nuthatch will begin to visit the bird feeders in Kansas. Winter Math: The lampposts are the number 15, the snowmen are the number 4, and the trees are the number 3. Then in the last equation, a light post with only one light would represent the number 5. If you go by the order of operations, 3 multiplied by 4 is 12, then if you add 15 and subtract 5 you'll get 22.
